

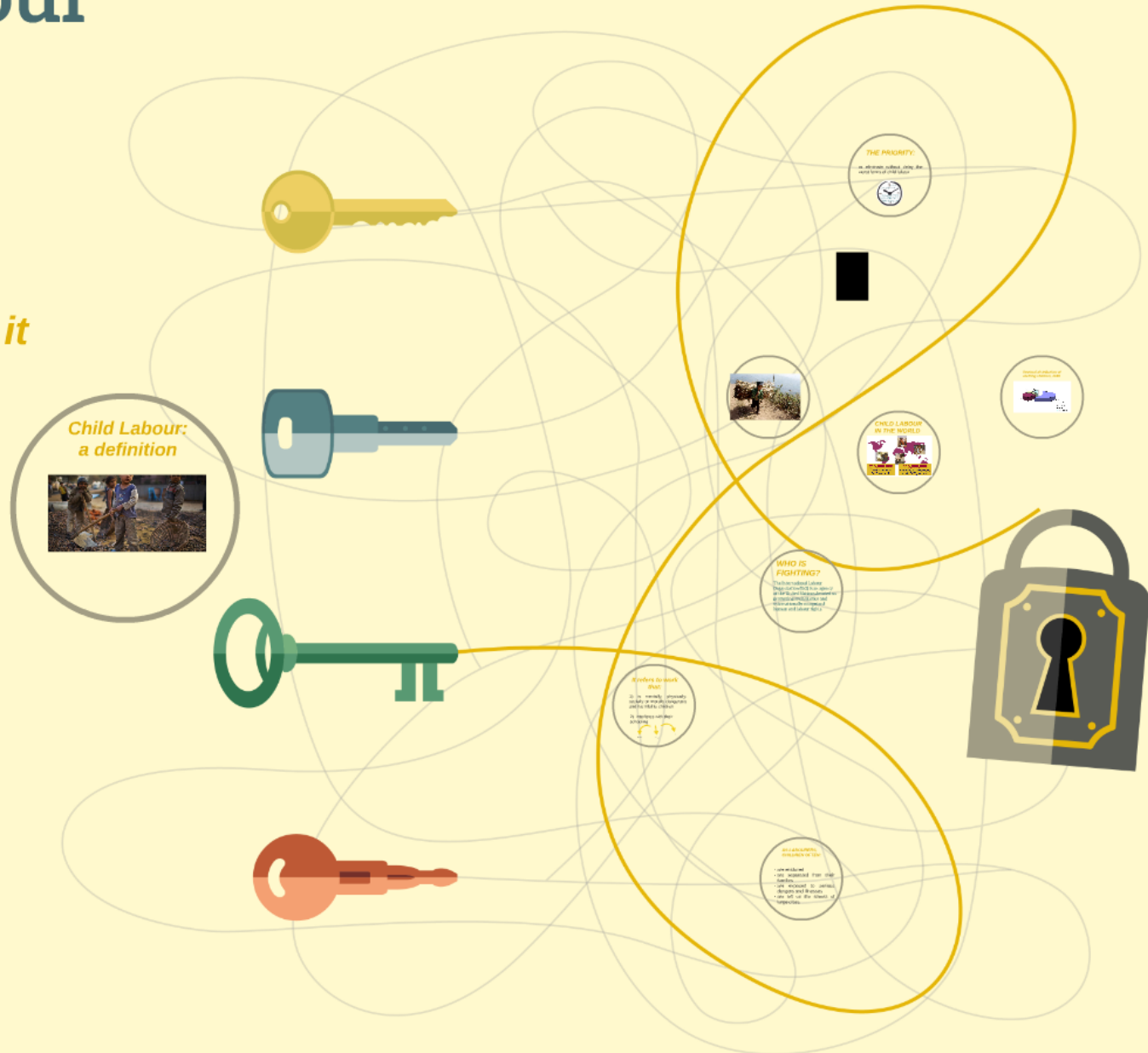

# *Child Labour: a definition*



Work that deprives children of their **childhood**, their **potential** and their **dignity**, and that is **harmful** to physical and mental **development**.

## *It refers to work that:*

1) is mentally, physically, socially or morally dangerous and harmful to children

2) interferes with their schooling

# *ECONOMIC ACTIVITIES*

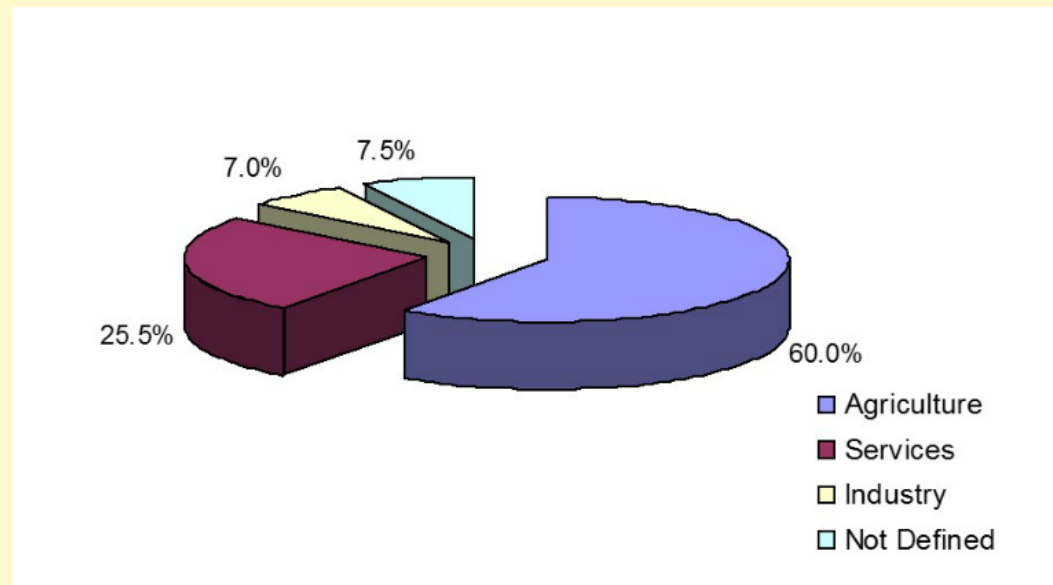


The **agriculture** sector: activities in agriculture, hunting, forestry, and fishing.

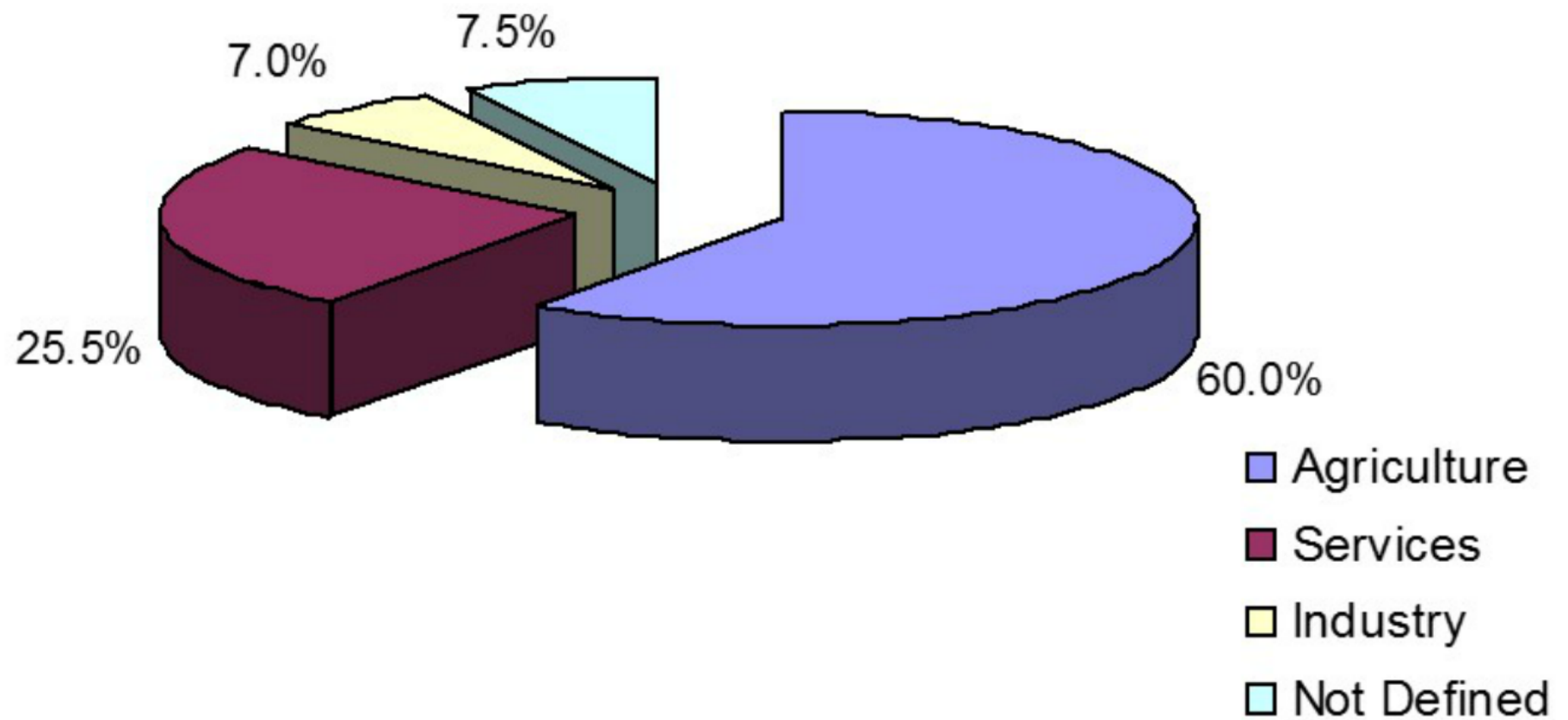
The **industry** sector includes mining and quarrying, manufacturing, construction, and public utilities (electricity, gas and water).

The **services** sector consists of wholesale and retail trade; restaurants and hotels; transport, storage, and communications; finance, insurance, real-estate, and business services.

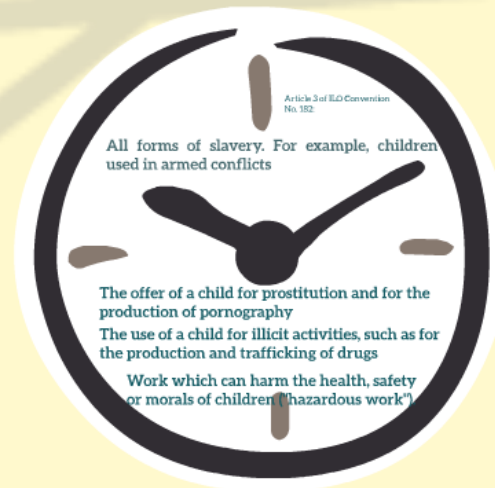


# ***WHO IS FIGHTING?***

The International Labour Organization (ILO) is an agency of the United Nations devoted to promoting social justice and internationally recognized human and labour rights.
